# Background

- Announced by the **President of the French Republic** during the G20 (July 2017)
- 12/12/17, the **2<sup>nd</sup> anniversary of the Paris Climate Agreement**, adopted during COP21 under French Presidency.
- Following **Donald Trump's decision** to withdraw from the Paris Agreement.
- At the heart of the **international climate agenda** and the **stepping up** of the implementation of the Paris Agreement:
  - November 2017: COP23, presided by Fiji
  - 12/12/2017: One Planet Summit
  - September 2018: Non-State Actors Summit, hosted by Governor Brown in California
  - December 2018: COP24, presided by Poland
  - September 2019: UNSG Climate Summit
  - 2020: Official entry into force of Paris Agreement



# Objectives

- **Celebrating the 2<sup>nd</sup> anniversary** of the Paris Agreement.
- **Involving** all State and non-State actors: the international community, private stakeholders, the financial sector, local governments, research bodies, NGOs.
- **Showcasing the work undertaken by the various stakeholders** since the Paris Agreement was adopted in 2015.
- **Encouraging stakeholders to step-up their commitments** to mitigate and adapt to climate change.
- Boosting public and private **financial resources** .



# Participants

- **States:** some 100 countries invited – geographical distribution, coalitions, regional groups and diplomats involved in climate issues
- **Non-State actors:** 800 organizations and network heads:
  - Public institutions: development banks, international organizations, etc.
  - Private players: companies, funds, banks, investors, start-ups, etc.
  - Civil society: NGOs, think tanks, foundations, youth networks, research bodies, etc.
  - Local governments: cities, regions, federated States, local government networks, etc.
- **French** government and agencies
- Estimate: **2,000 participants**

# General architecture

- *One Planet Summit*: 12 December
- Several approved side events will contribute to the momentum of the 12 December, notably:
  - 11/12 (morning): mainstreaming climate action – by the AFD and the IDFC
  - 11/12 (afternoon):
    - Climate Finance Day – by the Ministry of the Economy and Finance
    - “Gender and Climate” – by the Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs (TBC)
    - “Climate Justice” – by the Ministry for the Ecological and Inclusive Transition
  - Other events: Novethic, I4CE, OECD, IDDRI, CNES, MEDEF, etc.



# Expected outcomes

- **Announcements for bolstering climate finance**, redirecting investments, developing innovative financing instruments and supporting the ecological transition (especially by constructing stakeholder coalitions).
- **Presentation of concrete projects for transformation in different sectors** (renewable energies, clean transport, energy efficiency, construction, agriculture, forestry, etc.) enabled by various sources of financing, for the benefit of all.
